
We've designed our offices to provide comfortable working conditions in inspiring spaces.

Remote work

REMOTE WORK HAS BECOME A PART OF OUR CULTURE.

In practice, it means that we can do our work independently while remaining part of the team. To work like that we try to salvage and cling to some rules to be more flexible and transparent with each other

A few of them:

Time is important - take care of your calendar, it should reflect your workday schedule. Use "out of office" function when you are away.

Less is more - before inviting others to meeting, write down what you want to solve. Think if meeting all the participants is really required.

A well-prepared agenda is always nicely viewed by others. It should be adequate to the time of the meeting.

Work asynchronously as much as you can.










CODE PRINCIPLES



CLEAN, IDIOMATIC, READABLE

Make sure it's obvious what your code does and make it hard to misuse it.





SHORT, FUNCTIONAL

Functional code is usually shorter and easier to follow than a myriad of mixin classes. Only use OOP where it improves the developer's experience.



We don't ship junk. Make sure your code is covered by some automatic test suite.



THOROUGHLY REVIEWED

Make sure your critical code is diligently reviewed. Don't hesitate to ask for help across team boundaries.



EASY TO DEBUG

Use complex data structures sparingly, avoid reraising exceptions, and log all important state changes.



CONSISTENTLY IMPROVING

The best part is no part. Leave the codebase in a better state than it was before.



ON THE SHOULDERS OF GIANTS


Don't try to reinvent the wheel. Any established language will have a rich ecosystem of well-maintained tools.

BUILT TO PERFORM

Make sure your code will continue to work reasonably when the dataset is a thousand times larger. Avoid the "n+1 selects" problem when using external resources. Use asynchronous I/O where possible, asynchronous code scales much better than a pool of synchronous workers.



BUILT TO LAST

All external resources will eventually fail. Make sure you handle that gracefully and don't let an external system bring you down through a chain of cascading failures. Use timeouts to protect against unresponsive servers, use circuit breakers to temporarily disable subsystems that are known to fail. Fail fast and gracefully when unable to handle a request.






Tools we use:

We use a wide range of methodologies from Lean Startup to Scrum, Scrumban, Kanban and Waterfall.












EVERYONE HAS SUPER POWERS
